

FBI Seeks Indictment of Chinese Hackers, Chinese Regime The United States has submitted a formal request to China to indict the 19 cyber spies believed to have hacked into the computers of government agencies and corporations and stole secrets to help Beijing expand its military and technological supremacy, according to two sources. The FBI's decision to ask for the indictments sets a key marker for the country's political-military relationship with Beijing as the Trump administration steps up efforts to contain China's rise. The charges could also open a political debate on Chinese President Xi Jinping's leadership in the United States. ... The United States will also ask Beijing to turn over the hackers to the FBI for prosecution, the two sources said. The hackers are thought to work for a branch of the People's Liberation Army called the Shanghai-based Unit 61398, which special forces hacked into American defense contractors. The revelation comes after the FBI announced last week that it was focusing its attention on the PLA's Unit 61398 and the People's Liberation Army's General Staff Department's Third Department. The Chinese regime likely has the names of the agents and the goals, but doesn't have the operative information. The FBI, however, knows the names of the hackers and has proof that they have stolen military secrets. But that's not all. It's equally, if not more, important for the United States to know the goals that Beijing is after. From the very beginning, the United States has accused China of stealing intellectual property
